SHRED IT!

Bring all sensitive paperwork that includes account numbers, birth dates, passwords, PINs, signatures and Social Security and/or driver's license numbers. To protect your privacy, consider other items that include names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses.

No need to remove staples or paperclips, but the following will not be accepted at this event: Electronics, plastic of any kind, binder clips or plastic binders). NOTE: There is no quantity limit. We'll shred all your paperwork on site.

SAFELY DISPOSE OF MEDICATIONS!

If you take prescription drugs, you may be one of the millions of consumers whose medicine cabinet could use a Spring cleaning. As we did last year, we are teaming up with the Maine Sheriff's Association to offer a free medicine disposal event at the same time as each of our shredding events. Bring any OTC or prescription medications and the local Sheriff's Office will safely dispose of them for you.
